1 Introduction

1.1 What is StreamHijacker

StreamHijacker is a small Open Source stream ripper application. With this application you can save video or audio contents from the internet radios or video servers without any modifications and data loss. You can split the contents to separated files and you can save tracklist to HTML or TXT format. When you using the file splitter you can save PLS or M3U playlist.

With the inbuild ShoutCast radio station browser you can search radio stations and with a single click can starting the ripping. The whole playlist is stroing in recent list. You can set the maximum recent list count.

The files plitter doesn't allow to use CUE list saving because the separated files are doesn't needs cue list. Use the PLS, M3U or HTML, TXT tracklists with file splitter.

The program can monitoring the empty space in the destination hard drive and when it's under 200MBytes the ripping is closing by the program itself. On the settings form you can see the empty space on the selected hard drive.

Actually it's supporting the schedulded recording. Just set up a correct date, time and the duration of the ripping. Add a radio address what do you like to record. On the selected date and time the record is starting on the radio station what do you type to the radio address. The maximum length of the schedulded recording is 24 hours 59 minutes and 59 seconds. The other settings are used to schedulded recording too!

1.2 Installation

Just unpack the StreamHijacker to what do you want. When you start the program it shows the license file and the settings form.

- 1. Select the destination folder with Browse button.
- 2. Change the maximum recent numbers
- 3. Set up the scroller speed

The basic installation was ended with this instructions.

1.3 How to use StreamHijacker

StreamHijacker was designed to an easy-to-use application. Just select a station or address from the inbuild ShoutCast browser or the recent list and push the Hijack It! button. The progress informations are showed on the scrolled text fieldon "On The Radio" section. If the message is too length then it's scrolling left to right and backward. About the current stream you can find a quick info on the main form. It show you the total ripping time the radio content (like: MP3, AAC, NSV, etc...) and the bitrate in kilobits per seconds.

The stream info or the current song info it's showed when you push the info button. The info show you the stream or song length, bitrate, stream type, radio name and address, stream genre and the received data. On the Statistics tab you can see what happens under saving the content from the radio station.

The recorded songs and the song length are showed on the Songlist when you push the "Rip List" button if you using the file splitter option.

To the application just click to the "Minimize" to the top. It's between the About and Exit buttons. The hidden application is restoring when you take double click to the StreamHijacker icon on the system tray or you select the "Show" item on the menu.

If you have an address what you like and want to use it in StreamHijacker just open the program and type it to the address field. When you push the Hijack It! button the address what you was type is saving to the recent list.

1.4 Features

StreamHijacker have the folowing features:

•	Recent list
•	Showing ripped songs in a list
•	Settings
•	Showing the current song (if MetaData exists)
•	Information panel
•	Show informations about current song and / or about the current stream
•	Shoutcast radio browser (Download from www.shoutcast.com)
•	Playlist file downloading
•	Ripping to separated files (File splitter)
•	Recent list is changeable
•	Song list creation (TXT or HTML format)
•	Winamp emulation
•	Split to new folder
•	Destination folder for splits and ripped streams
•	Hiding to system tray icon
•	CUE file creator
•	Schedulded recording
•	PLS and M3U playlist

StreamHijacker supporting the following formats and protocols:

•	ShoutCast Protocol
•	IceCast Protocol
•	HTTP/1.1 Protocol
•	AAC, AAC+, MP3, MPEG, NSV streams
•	WMV, WMA, MP3 download over shoutcast or icecast protocol
•	PLS downloading (only with the shoutcast browser)
•	PLS and M3U playlists

2 Support

2.1 FAQ

- Q: After i stop the recording the program show me "Connection closed Gracefully". What does it mean? Is that a problem?
- A: When the connection was closed down on the client and server side then it show this message. This is a normal operation not a problem.
- Q: The program still showing "Buffering" or "Preparing" message on the main window. What's the problem?
- A: You must open your firewall for StreamHijacker or you lost your internet connection.
- Q: The program shows "I/O Error 103" message and the record was stopped. What does it mean?
- A: You don't have permisson to write to the destination folder or the destination file was locked by an another application. (Try to close down your antivirus software and check the permissons of the destination folder.)
- Q: The ShoutCast station browser can't download the list. What can i do?
- A: Check your firewall rules and check manually the <u>www.shoutcast.com</u> page. If you still have the problem please let me know.
- Q: The schedulded record doesn't started but i was set it up. Why?
- A: You must provide a valid address in schedulded record settings and must enable the schedulder. If your internet connection is poor or your firewall was closed the StreamHijacker can't reach the destination address and can't start the ripping.
- Q: The songlist shows me only one song. Why?
- A: This is a normal operation when you ripping from a radio what doesn't have new song identifier.
- Q: The program shows me "Metadata error!" message. What's the problem?
- A: The selected radio station doesn't have metadata interval. StreamHijacker doesn't supporting radio stations what doesn't have metadata.
- Q: What "Winamp emulation" means?
- A: Radio stations are identify the stream client. With this option the StreamHijacker seems like a standard Winamp.
- Q: During the ripping the StreamHijacker shows me an "Stopped because no more free space on drive..." error message and the programs stopped the ripping by itself. Why?
- A: The free space is lower then 200MBytes on the selected hard drive.
